Those tags are assembled in the United States by adults with disabilities. Depending on the size and style, prices for one of these incredible works of art range from \$20–\$55.

By purchasing a Blessing Basket, you empower families around the world not just to exist, but to thrive. You bring hope to the weaver who made the basket and joy to the person receiving it. Let the things in your Blessing Basket encourage you and remind you of all the blessings in your life and the blessings you have bestowed on others. *Each basket sold is a life changed.*
